BACKGROUND

The Irvin L. Young Memorial Library offers online instructor-facilitated Spanish courses-which can be catered to specific subject matter. Employees simply need to obtain a library card and connect with a library staff member to get registered for the training.

Currently three staff members from the PD have registered for the 24-hour “Spanish for Law Enforcement” training, one of whom has completed it. The employees have completed the online training modules through a mix of on-duty and off-duty time.

My request is to offer an incentive of 1 paid vacation day for any staff member who successfully completes the course, ideally city-wide, but at least within the PD. Completing the course is a major benefit to the city given the current influx of Spanish speakers, so I believe employees should be incentivized to complete the course regardless of whether they use on-duty or off-duty time to do so.
